

# Information on data protection for participants in the 15<sup>th</sup> International Conference in Monte Carlo & Quasi-Monte Carlo Methods in Scientific Computing (MCQMC 2022)

On this page, you receive information about the way and for what purpose we process personal data in the course of the conference. In addition, we inform you about your rights in connection with the processing of your data.

The conference is organized in cooperation between the Österreichische Akademie der Wissenschaften (Austrian Academy of Sciences) and the Johannes Kepler Universität Linz (Johannes Kepler University Linz). With regard to this cooperation, the organizing organizations jointly determine the purposes and means of the processing of personal data of participants and speakers in the course of the conference and are considered and have concluded an agreement as joint controllers with the meaning of Art 4.7 in conjunction with Art 26 GDPR.

## Legal Basis and Purpose for Data Processing

The legal basis of processing your data is your registration for, your participation in and the performance of the conference (Art 6 (1) b GDPR; performance of the contract), the compliance with legal obligations (Art 6 (1) c GDPR; accounting obligations), a legitimate interest (Art 6 (1) f GDPR, performance and documentation of the conference) of the organizing organizations or your consent (Art 6 (1) a GDPR, publication of your name and affiliation on the conference website). If processing is based on your consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before the withdrawal.

Your data will be processed for the administration of the conference (including registration, accommodation and travel arrangements, billing etc.), to provide you with information about (e.g. changes, deadlines, location) and documents of (e.g. program, proceedings) the conference as well as for the documentation of the conference (including photos and streaming). Please note that the keynote lectures of the conference will be streamed live via Zoom, available only for the scientific community interested in the subject area. The Live-Stream will not be recorded or made available to the broader public.

## Data categories

We process the following categories of data:

Identification data (name, gender, affiliation), contact details (e-mail address), payment data, travel data (arrival and departure day and, if necessary, processing data for the hotel booking, if this was requested)

## Recipients

Your data will be forwarded to a payment service provider for the payment processing as well as to hotels, (if booking was requested). If you give your consent, your name and affiliation will be published on the conference website. Furthermore, a Live-Stream of the keynote lectures of the conference will be made available to the scientific community interested in the subject area.

## **Retention Period**

Your data will be stored as long as necessary for the administration and documentation of the conference or legally requested or permitted.

## **Your rights**

You have the right to request access to and rectification or erasure of personal data or restriction of processing or to object to processing as well as the right to data portability. Furthermore, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority in Austria or another EU member state. The Austrian supervisory authority is:
